

Project Description

I designed this project as an area for tourists in the last year of my school. We were asked to use an area we would choose in the Hazzapulo Passage in Taksim, Istanbul. The area I chose was a tall narrow building.

There is a place called 'Sabahçı Kahvesi' in my country. I wanted to give this name to my project. These are the coffeehouses where people who do not have a place to stay can stay. They can stay overnight without eating or drinking. It is not as comfortable as the hotel but it is a place to shelter.

I adapted the scheme describing the stages of sleep to the building. The lower floors are awake, then nonrem sleep and rem sleep. So the movement decreases as it goes up. There is a lot of circulation in the lower floors. Activities such as sitting and chatting are carried out on the middle floors. On the upper floors, rest and maybe a little nap.
